

A specialist in French-language education comes to Ottawa!

If you have questions about your child's education in French and are looking for ways to help your child when attending a French school, you will want to meet Glen Taylor, an expert in French-language education in English Canada, when he visits Ottawa from November 16 to 26.

He is the author of the 2007 book *FUSION: Raising a Bilingual Child in a Two-Language Household*. Interested in "exogamy" for a number of years, he uses this term to describe the common Canadian reality where there is a "union of two individuals with different mother tongues and cultural backgrounds."

Glen Taylor works closely with school boards and parent associations across the country to help couples take part in their children's French-language education. He has given many workshops and written several publications on the subject. All families living in a bilingual household will want to attend one of the presentations, which are taking place at 10 different French-language schools across Ottawa on weekday evenings and two Saturday afternoons.
