

New location, new routes, still helping kids with cancer!

CN Cycle for CHEO, the region's first cycle, walk and in-line skating event of the season is moving to a brand new location. On Sunday, May 2nd, 2010, The Canadian War Museum on the Ottawa River Parkway will provide the start/finish line for all events, and a beautiful backdrop for the vast array of event day activities.

All money raised at CN Cycle for CHEO will go to help kids with cancer. The Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario is the main beneficiary, with a portion of proceeds also going to Candlelighters and Ronald McDonald House.

Things will kick off at 8:20 a.m., just before the start of the Accenture cycle, with the "Tribute to Tori's Angels" ceremony. At the age of nine, Tori lost her courageous battle with cancer. "It's a fitting tribute. 'Tori's Angels' serves as a memorial to Tori and all of the kids who have fought their battle but have sadly died from this disease," says Kevin Keohane, VP Development and Community Relations at the CHEO Foundation. "That's why we all gather together, to raise money to do all we can for children and youth in our region who find themselves battling cancer."
